



PERMIT TO ALLOW MINOR USE OF AN AGVET CHEMICAL PRODUCT

FOR CONTROL OF FAIRY RING IN GOLF GREENS

PERMIT NUMBER - PER14379

This permit is issued to the Permit Holder in response to an application granted by the APVMA under section 112 of the Agvet Codes of the jurisdictions set out below. This permit allows a person, as stipulated below, to use the product in the manner specified in this permit in the designated jurisdictions. This permit also allows any person to claim that the product can be used in the manner specified in this permit.

THIS PERMIT IS IN FORCE FROM 1 OCTOBER 2013 to 30 SEPTEMBER 2017.

Product to be used:

MONSTAR SC FUNGICIDE

PLUS OTHER REGISTERED PRODUCTS

Containing: 464 g/L FLUTOLANIL as their only active constituent.

Directions for Use:

Situation	Disease	Rate
GOLF GREENS	Fairy ring (<i>Basidiomycetes</i> spp.)	130 - 200 mL product in 40 - 190 L of water + non-ionic surfactant per 100m ²

Critical Use Comments:

- **Preventative:** For green areas where fairy ring has occurred previously, apply at lower rate during late October to early November (prior to dry conditions). If required re-apply after 30 days.
- **Curative:** Apply at higher rate at first signs of infection and re-apply 30 days after first application.
- Fungicide should be mixed with water and non-ionic surfactant, and applied by boom or garden/lawn type sprayer (commonly referred to as a fish tail fan applicator) to allow large volumes of the mix to be applied to the affected area with even and thorough coverage. Treated areas should be irrigated prior to and after application with sufficient water to maintain growth of turf.
- DO NOT apply under meteorological conditions or from spray equipment that could be expected to cause spray to drift onto adjacent areas, particularly wetlands, waterbodies or water courses.

Jurisdiction:

ACT, NSW, QLD, SA, TAS, VIC, NT and WA only.

Additional Conditions:

DO NOT apply more than 400 mL of product per 100m² of product in total per year (with no single application greater than 200 mL of product per 100m²).

DO NOT apply with a re-treatment interval of less than 30 days.

DO NOT apply with backpack equipment or any hand held spray wand. Apply only with a boom or garden/lawn type sprayer (commonly referred to as a fish tail fan applicator).

DO NOT apply with spray droplets smaller than a COARSE spray droplet size category according to nozzle manufacturer specifications that refer to the ASAE S572 Standard or the British Crop Production Council guideline.

DO NOT apply if there are aquatic and wetland areas including aquacultural ponds, surface streams and rivers within 30 metres downwind from the application area, unless a shrouded sprayer is used.

DO NOT apply unless target area has been cored prior to application to ensure the product penetrates into the soil.

DO NOT apply to any area where fairy ring is not present at the time of application, except in areas where fairy ring was present the previous year.

DO NOT apply to any area other than golf greens. Use on fairways, tee beds, or any other area is not permitted.

DO NOT apply unless the following safety directions are observed:

SAFETY DIRECTIONS

Will irritate the eyes. Avoid contact with eyes. When mixing and applying, wear chemical resistant clothing buttoned to the neck and wrist, a washable hat, a disposable face mask covering mouth and nose, a face shield or goggles and chemical resistant gloves. After use and before eating, drinking or smoking, wash hands, arms and face thoroughly with soap and water. After each days use, wash gloves, face shield or goggles and contaminated clothing.

This Permit provides for the use of a product in a manner other than specified on the approved label of the product. Unless otherwise stated in this permit, the use of the product must be in accordance with instructions on its label.

Persons who wish to prepare for use and/or use products for the purposes specified in this permit must read, or have read to them, the details and conditions of this permit.
