DIRECTIONS FOR USE

Add 48mL of ABSOLVE to 100 litres of water. Spray fruit and vegetables or submerge them in solution. Ensure a minimum of 45 seconds contact time and provide adequate draining time.

NOT TO BE USED FOR ANY PURPOSE, OR IN ANY MANNER CONTRARY TO THIS LABEL, UNLESS AUTHORISED UNDER APPROPRIATE LEGISLATION.

WITHHOLDING PERIOD: NOT REQUIRED WHEN USED AS DIRECTED.

PROTECTION OF WILDLIFE, FISH, CRUSTACEANS AND ENVIRONMENT: DO NOT contaminate streams, rivers or waterways with the chemical or used containers.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL: Keep out of reach of children. Store in the closed, original container in a cool, wellventilated area. Do not store for prolonged periods in direct sunlight. Triple-rinse containers before disposal. Add rinsings to spray tank. Do not dispose of undiluted chemicals on site. If recycling, replace cap and return clean container to recycler or designated collection point. If not recycling, break, crush or puncture and deliver empty packaging to an approved waste management facility. If an approved waste management facility is not available, bury the empty packaging 500mm below the surface in a disposal pit specifically marked and set up for this purpose clear of waterways, desirable vegetation and tree roots, in compliance with relevant local, state or territory government regulations. Do not burn empty containers or product.

This container can be recycled if it is clean, dry, free of visible residues and has the drumMUSTER logo visible. Triple-rinse container for disposal. Dispose of rinsate by adding it to the spray tank. Do not dispose of undiluted chemical on site. Wash outside of the container and the cap. Store cleaned container in a sheltered place with cap removed. It will then be acceptable for recycling at any drumMUSTER collection or similar container management program site. The cap should not be replaced, but may be taken separately.

SAFETY DIRECTIONS: Poisonous if absorbed by skin contact, inhaled or swallowed. Corrosive, attacks eyes and skin. The product is strongly acidic, the liquid can cause burns. Spray/dip will irritate the nose and throat, may irritate the eyes and skin. Avoid contact with eyes and skin. Do not inhale vapour or spray mist. When opening the container, preparing product for use and using the product wear cotton overalls

over normal clothing, buttoned to the neck and wrist and a washable hat, elbow-length chemical resistant gloves, half facepiece respirator, goggles and impervious footwear. Leave room/other area immediately after activating fogger. Thoroughly ventilate treated areas before reoccupying. Wash hands after use. After each day's use, wash gloves, goggles, contaminated clothing and respirator, if rubber wash respirator with detergent and warm water. Do not re-use footwear until thoroughly aired.

FIRST AID: If poisoning occurs, contact a doctor or Poisons Information Centre. Phone Australia 131 126; New Zealand 0800 764 766. If swallowed do NOT induce vomiting. If skin contact occurs, remove contaminated clothing and wash skin thoroughly. If in eyes, hold eyes open, flood with water for at least 15 minutes and see a doctor.
